- Economics will accept IEMS 303 and IEMS 304 in place of Stat 210 and Econ 281. IEMS will not accept Stat 210 and Econ 281.
- Economics will accept IEMS 373 in place of a 300-level field course. IEMS 373 counts as an IE/OR elective for the IE major.
- Double counting of IEMS 304 and IEMS 373 should be noted on the petition to graduate, completed at the end of
